



**CODE OF CONDUCT
YOUTH SCIENCE ADVENTURE CAMPS
Ages 6-11**

PLEASE BRING THIS FORM WITH YOU TO BIG CREEK

SAFETY FIRST

Students may not engage in behavior which threatens the safety or causes injury to others.

**For instance, students may not throw rocks, pine cones or sticks. Taunting, pushing, or practical jokes that threaten safety are not allowed. If a conflict cannot be peaceably resolved, ask a staff member for help.

RESPECT

All students, guest presenters, and camp staff should be treated with respect.

**For instance, if someone else is speaking, you should be listening. If you have spoken, give someone else a chance to speak. Respect differences of opinion and give “*pleases*” and “*thank you’s*”, and help *freely*.

COOPERATION

Share the work. Share the space. Share the fun.

**For instance, if you want to use equipment, get permission first, use as intended, and put it away. Bunkhouses are *only* for sleeping and quiet activity. If you are having fun, invite others to join you. If you have a question, need help, or have a suggestion to share, contact a staff person or friend.
