The Glacier Institute is following federal, state, and local precautions related to the coronavirus. At this time, we are not taking any drastic measures, and plan to proceed as planned with our summer activities. We have been working in close partnership with the National Park Service and National Forest Service to assess the risks, and there is no plan to close either Field Camp (in Glacier National Park) or Big Creek Camp (in Flathead National Forest) at this time.
